CONVENIENT VIRTUAL CARE FOR WOMEN

- Routine check-in after a surgery or other procedure
- Remote antenatal monitoring for blood pressure, glucose control, and asthma symptoms
- Discussing lab results
- Anxiety and Depression screening and referrals
- Medication refills & counseling along with postpartum contraceptive counseling
- Counseling for risk assessment for BRCA testing
- Preeclampsia screening and prevention
